Most of their vines grow in Morgon, an appellation known for dense, long-lived wines and whose most famous site is Côte du Py—a collapsed cone of a volcano notable for iron-rich, blue-stoned schist soils that foster wines of great elegance and structure. The Depardons farm 7.5 acres on top of Py and age this wine in huge old casks.
