Ripasso DOC Della Valpolicella is made by re-passing (Ripasso) Valpolicella wine with the leftover grape skins and seeds from fermented Amarone with extended maceration. Many of the rich complexities of Amarone like the color, tannis and softness that attribute to the drying of the grapes are passed on to Valpolicella using this method. Like Amarone, it is made with a blend of three historic varietals that have been meticulously curated prior to bottling. These noble grapes together make Verona's most important and oldest red wine that date back to the Romans.
