Tiny berries packed tight with flavor are unmistakably Mount Veeder. This wild, rugged terrain produces a wine of unparalleled beauty. Restrained on the nose and the front of the palate, but patience is rewarded with a concentration of flavor hitting the back of your throat and lingering for an impossibly long finish. This high altitude vineyard, sitting above the marine fog, allows long ripening and development of blackberry, anise and a touch of white pepper in the profile.
