Château Ribebon overlooks the Dordogne river that gives life to the historical 80-hectare property. Louis XVI used the magnificent building as a shooting lodge in the XVII century. The vineyard is planted with Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon & Cabernet Franc in clay-limestone and gravel soils. Great care is taken in the vineyards and at the winery to sort the grapes so only the finest selection is used. The resulting wine is complex, well balanced and sophisticated. It has an intense color, a nose of concentrated red and black fruits and a rich, elegant taste which reflects the expression of the terroir and quality of the grapes.
