Afterwards, they are sorted and gently pressed to release a rosy juice with aromas of fresh strawberries and a hint of minerality. The wine's pleasant acidity and beautiful pale pink color are the perfect accompaniment to grilled chicken over peppery arugula, or simply on its own on a warm summer night. Cheers to rose all day!
