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Rum Punch

James Ashley was only 33 years old when he opened the London Coffee and Punch-House in 1731. Almost immediately his punch became world famous, including praise from Benjamin Franklin. Although Ashley's mixture of rum, citrus, sugar, and spices does not adhere to the original definition of the cocktail (notably it lacks bitters), his punch was advertised as being "mixed to order" and served in a single serving called a "tiff" or "rub". Therefore, according to our modern definition of cocktail, Ashley's Punch House would've been one of the first cocktail bars in history! At B&K, our motto is "Be Modern, Drink Classic". So, while punch might not technically be a cocktail, we feel Ashley should be honored as the inventor of the modern cocktail bar. Also, this punch is darn good! Pour over ice and enjoy.
