Today at Amici we continue our tradition of making small production, carefully crafted wines to share with friends. Because we insist on keeping our production small, we can carefully control the process of creating each wine, crafting what we like to consider a small work of art in each bottle.

Our 2009 Sauvignon Blanc is a blend of the best grapes from a small vineyard located on the valley floor between the towns of Vacaville and the Siterado Trail. The blend wine is a blend of 50% Sauvignon Blanc and 50% Muscadine clone. This is a crisp, dry white with flavors of guava and spice that will impress even the most discriminating of Sauvignon Blanc fans. Serve this wine lightly chilled, paired with virtually any summer food. It goes especially well with grilled fish, poultry and light pasta dishes.
