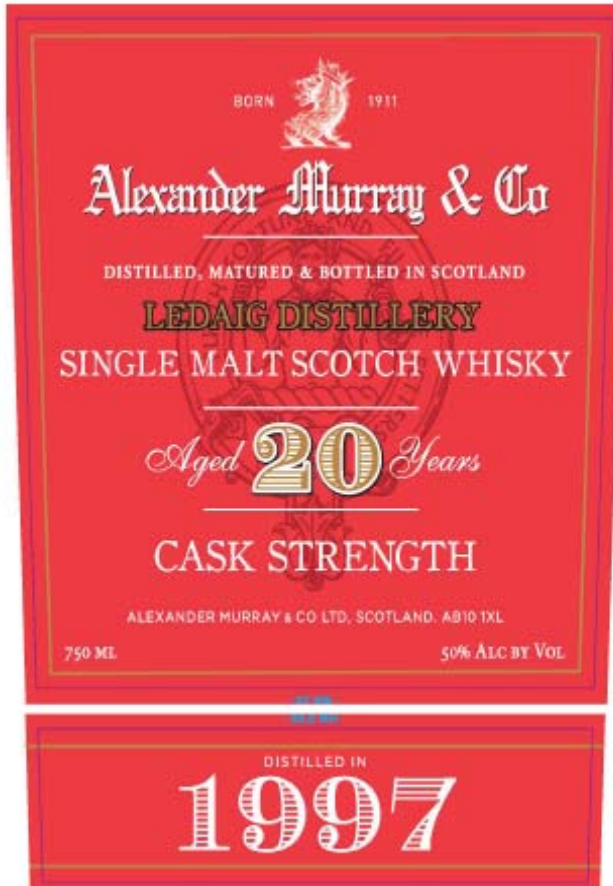

Alexander Murray & Co presents a fine expression of Island single malt from Ledaig Distillery. Distilled at the Tobermory Distillery on the Isle of Mull, 'Ledaig' is the lesser-known, peated variant produced only a small fraction of the year. This 1997 vintage has a lovely display of balance: crisp citrus, dry and earthy peat, and sweet, textured barley sugar come together to please the palate.
