During Prohibition, a loophole in the law known as Section 29 made it legal to produce 200 GALLONS of wine a year for personal use. In those days, Alicante Bouschet was the most popular choice of grape for depth and flavour, and today our first choice for making this wine. Alicante Bouschet originates from the south of France but has found its fame in the sun-drenched vineyards of Portugal. Dark in colour, it has an intense, ripe aroma of dark cherries, plums and sweet baking spices from six months' ageing in French and American oak casks. The smooth palate is concentrated and richly flavoured, with a juicy fruit finish.
