+ Story: The word "Pinot" is said to come from the French term for pine (pin) cone. It happens that the small grape bunches bear a resemblance to the woody cone of a conifer. Long ago in Burgundy, Pinot Gris sometimes grew among the vines of Pinot Noir, playing hide and seek with the harvester. The roots of this Pinot Gris are in the vineyards of northern and central California. This is a lighthearted, laid back wine with a serious desire to please.

+ Taste: Bright with a pinkish hue, or rosy glow. Cascading aromas of peaches, apricots and citrus give way to an emergence of lustrous floral and mineral flavors. The wine has a really nice and good body with a finish that's not too sweet. Fix it up with a creamy wild mushroom risotto, arugula and prosciutto pizza, or nothing at all.
