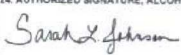

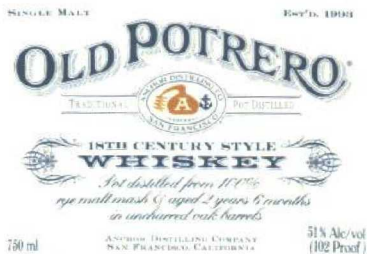

The recipient was aged for two years five months and the silver we have given you is a blend of balanced complexity to taste experience Old Potrero's traditional heritage.
