Each summer afternoon as the mercury climbs, low pressure from rising heat pulls chilled air from the Monterey Bay down the Salinas Valley. As the winds accelerate through the narrowing mountain ranges they reach speeds up to 24 knots – nearly 30 miles per hour. This daily phenomenon is a crucial cooling mechanism for our Pinot Noir vineyards, located 60 km south of the bay. The tempering effect of the winds extends hang-times, allowing the grapes to slowly develop intense fruit aromas while maintaining exquisite balance and structure.
