The wine-making process includes hand selected grapes and natural methods guaranteeing vinification in the purest way possible. No oak is used during fermentation. Obtained largely from Fiano grapes and the rest from other varieties of white grapes, was vinification in white, to temperature-controlled. It goes well with white meats and fish in the oven.
