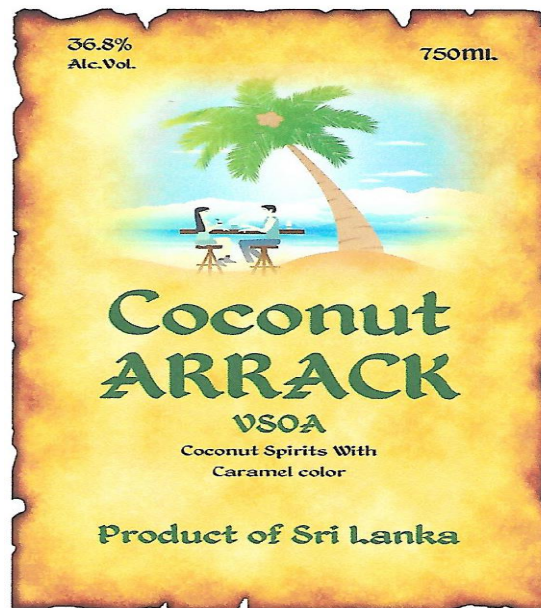

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Arrack

Arrack, distilled from a naturally fermented alcoholic beverage, it is a liquid that contains a history that goes back several millennia and encompasses a long and delicate process from coconut palm to the glass. The extracted sap from the flower of a coconut palm (Cocos Nusifera), Collected and placed in wooden vats made from "Halmilla" (Berrya cordifolia). The liquid ferments quickly in to a mildly alcoholic drink locally called coconut "toddy". Then begins the process of distillation and the raw spirit is mellowed by a process of maturation and blended by master blenders to a formula handed down from generations.
