#### YAMAHAI SHIBORITATE NAMACHOZO SAKE

Kasumi Tsuru, a small artisan saké brewer founded in 1725, has earned a reputation for brewing some of Japan's finest examples of *kimoto* and *yamahai* style saké.

*Yamahai* is the traditional, ancient method of saké making that yields saké of richer, deeper flavors and body. *Shiboritate* means the saké is freshly pressed, which gives it a fresh, youthful, brash quality. *Namachozo* means the saké has been pasteurized only one time, right after bottling.
