Vinification

Gentle Saignée method used to maintain the fresh fruit of the juice, native ferment in seasoned French barriques, occasional stirring to aid body, partial native ML to lend richness and weight yet portion of malic retained for balance and freshness.

Site

Our Annadel Gap Vineyard is most influenced by the cool fog from the Petaluma Gap. This combined with the narrowing of the Annadel Gap, concentrates wind flows, creating growing conditions more similar to the Russian River. The soil is a fine-grained sandy clay loam, reminiscent of the famous Goldridge soils, interspersed with fractured shale, alluvial gravels and cobbled stone series.
