Amongst the twisted vines of our ancestry were the families of de Marisco, who in the twelfth and thirteenth centuries inhabited the island of Lundy off the south-west coast of England. This wine honours one of their many stories...

William de Marisco – having been outlawed by King Henry III in 1235, fled to Lundy island where he turned to piracy to sustain his existence. Due to the betrayal of one of his associates, William was captured by a storming party on the island in 1242 and carted off to London to face charges of piracy and treason.

Found guilty – he was executed with 'peculiar ignominy' – being hung, drawn and quartered – indeed **a sticky end**.

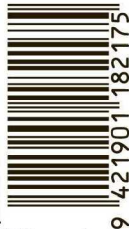
