The vines of « Chemin de Provence » are located just north of Aix en Provence. This sun baked terrain produce grapes with loads of character and extraction suitable for the aromatic rosé we produce. In the nose, red fruits come out with more exotic fruits like guava in the background. In the mouth, the palate is fresh and clean, emphasizing ripe strawberries and perfectly balanced acidity. Serve between 10 and 12°C.
