The vines for this bottling were planted in 1994. It is a sustainably farmed vineyard with substantial buffer zones and protected riparian areas.

This wine was hand-picked, hand-sorted, and fermented in French oak barrels. The rich floral elements, especially honeysuckle, are typical and the strength of the Viognier variety.

A total of 250 cases were produced.
