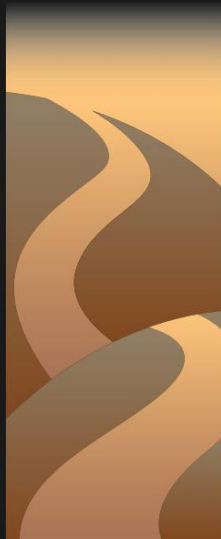

Whisper Path Cellars is a family owned and operated winery established in 2017 dedicated to producing premium Texas wines using 100% Texas grapes. It is with great pride that we introduce our 2017 Viognier, our very first release.

This white wine is produced with grapes from Bingham Family Vineyards in the Texas High Plains. Grapes were harvested at 2 a.m. on the morning of August 6, arriving at our winery via refrigerated truck soon afterward. Fermented and aged in stainless steel tanks, this wine exhibits aromas of grapefruit and tangerine, with flavors of peach, apricot, and a hint of pineapple. This wine is best served chilled.
