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AMARO ALTA VERDE

Amaro Alta Verde is of a profile that was long ago more common throughout the Adriatic, though seldom found in the last half century. It's principal ingredient is assenzio, a variety of wormwood, as well a number of complementary herbs, citrus and spice. The aromas are of the summer forest in all it's verdant splendor. To the taste, there is the signature long and complex bitterness extending from the tip of tongue and resonating in the back palate. This is intertwined with a slight sweetness and bright herbal notes that give levity and balance.

This style of amaro is best enjoyed with tonic and citrus or over ice with a big squeeze of lemon. In cocktails, Alta Verde can add tremendous depth and yield a drying effect to balance otherwise sweet drinks.
