TeHo

Altamira, Mendoza.

TeHo means "blood of the earth" in the local Huarpe Indian language of Mendoza. This wine is meant to represent the essence of the privileged Malbec terroir of Altamira. This high altitude (4,000' elevation), cool climate growing area of Altamira has a very unique soil profile which is at the core of TeHo.

The soils of Altamira are very diverse, with patches of sandy, rocky and silty soils dispersed throughout the vineyard. For TeHo, we isolate each soil type to manage, harvest, and vinify separately. Four different lots go into the TeHo wines: sandy soils with floral aromatics are co-fermented with Cabernet Franc; rocky soils with stony minerality is all Malbec; silty soils for dark fruit profile are co-fermented with Petit Verdot for additional structure; a small lot of Petit Verdot from rocky soils is co-fermented with Malbec. This process of managing the micro-terroirs of each soil type makes TeHo the "blood of the earth" from Altamira.
