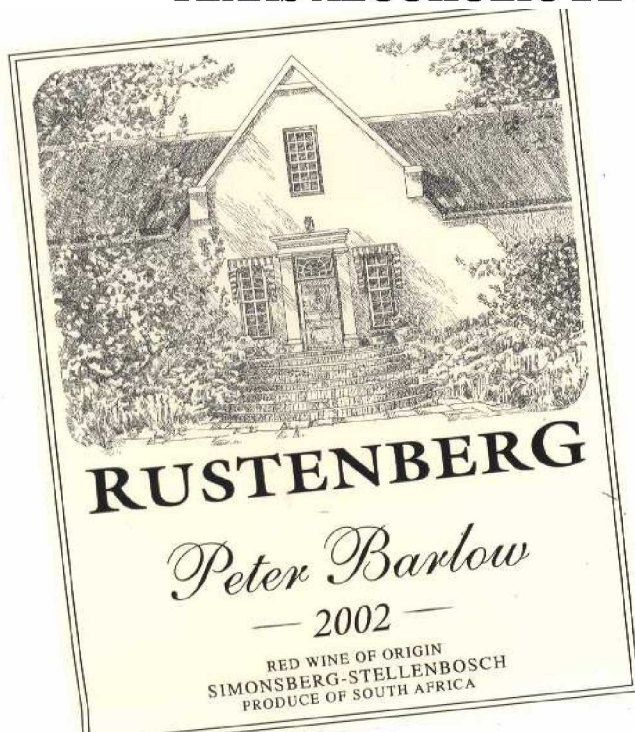

A classic **Cabernet Sauvignon** from Stellenbosch that captures the unique characteristics of the terroir. The grapes are hand-picked from selected rows of mountainside vines and then the berries are sorted by hand at the cellar before vinification. The fine-grained tannins are indicative of a superb vintage. Matured in new French barriques for 20 months, this multi-layered wine will repay 10-15 years' further bottle maturation in ideal cellar conditions.

The name pays tribute to the man who recognised the wine-growing potential of Rustenberg, which he bought in 1940.
