The label depicts a silver lizard previously used as an adornment by the Mapuches, who are local indigenous Chileans. Lien means "silver metal" in the Mapuche language.

Wine Maquis' Lien is a hand-crafted blend of Syrah, Carménère, Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot and Malbec grapes, resulting in a distinctive wine that reflects the special plot of land the Hurtado Videla family owns in the Colchagua Valley in Chile.

The vineyards and winery are located at the confluence of two historic rivers, which brought down from the Andes sediments that established the vineyard's alluvial soils. The same river canyons channel cool breezes from the Pacific Ocean, contributing to the wine's rich fruit character.
