HEMELRAND VINE GARDEN

W.O. Hemel & Aarde Ridge, Walker Bay

Hemelrand farm is perched at 360 meters above sea level on a cold and windy watershed overlooking the valleys to the East and to the West. On clear days the ocean is visible in the distance. It's a marginal site with poor spoil. Thankfully grape vines are hardy things.

From the outset we wanted to make a single white wine from this place, drawing inspiration from the Mediterranean, the Hemel & Aarde, and the Cape's own heritage. This slow ripening vineyard was planted in 2010 to a handful of carefully selected white grape varieties. Proportions of these grapes will vary every vintage, the idea being to bottle the wine just as the vineyard produces it. This bottling is predominantly Roussanne, with some Chenin, Chardonnay and Verdelho each playing a part.

The vineyard is small, and is painstakingly tended by the owner, Hans, therefore the name Vine Garden.
