PINOT GRIS

Pinot Gris was first introduced into the United States by being planted in the Willamette Valley where it best performs in our long, cool growing season. Our Pinot Gris when matched with poached or broiled salmon enhances the flavor of the salmon- it is our "salmon wine".

These vines were tended by hand and cluster-thinned to increase flavor intensity. The grape clusters were picked at peak ripeness and lightly whole cluster pressed, not crushed, to produce the best flavors. The juice was fermented slowly at cold temperatures to enhance varietal flavor, conditioned sur-lee and stirred twice monthly. All of our vineyards are certified sustainable - LIVE (Low Input Viticulture and Enology) and Salmon Safe.

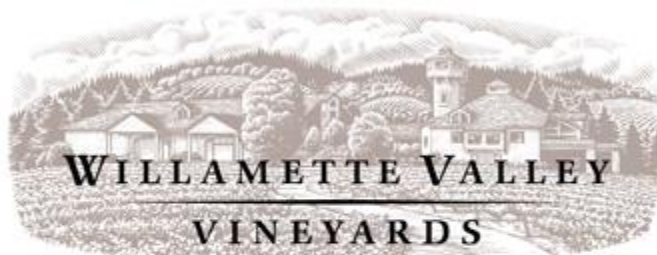
