During World War II, an airbase was established at the foothills of the Pecos and Mountains. After the war it was sold to the Miller Family. For four generations, the family has farmed the surrounding area using the old outposts as their farm headquarters. Some vines were planted at "Airfield" in 1968 and the family has been producing ever since.

WINEMAKERS NOTES The 2007 Tempranillo was full-bodied, rugged red with cherry, berries and aromas of dark cherry, licorice, pepper and spice. It is served with carne asada, roast lamb, prosciutto, and sautéed wild mushrooms. For cheeses try Manchego or Pecorino Romano.
