We pick Grenache specifically for our rosé production. The grapes are crushed and immediately pressed to stainless steel tank for a long cold fermentation. The wine is blended from various lots of Grenache that we saignée. Saignée is a winemaking process where we “bleed” off a portion of slightly pink juice from a red must right after crush. We then filter a bottle early to capture brightness and vibrancy. This is a refreshing spring and summer rosé for picnics and other activities.
