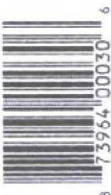
Château Saint-André-Corbin is a 47 acre vineyard perched on a hill north of St. Emilion on an estate that dates back to the Gallo-Roman era. Historical records suggest that this ancient estate belonged to the famous 4th century poet and Roman consul, Ausonius, and its wines were served on the table of the Caesars. The dynamic Saby family, owners of numerous vineyards in St. Emilion, took over the estate and made its first vintage in 2003. Exceptional, homogenous terroir of clay and limestone with excellent drainage. Average vine age of 55 years. Density of 2,500 vines per acre. Yield of 342 gallons per acre. Manual harvest. Modern vinification used to obtain maximum fruit and concentration. Aged 15 months in French oak barrels, 1/3 new. *Intense purple robe. Rich, fruity nose of exceptionally ripe Merlot, chocolate and toasty oak flavors. Full, round, lush, fruit-driven palate with excellent structure and balance, and silky tannins.*
