The vineyards are planted in the heart of the Corbières region in southern France, along the old Roman trade road Via Aquitania, which connected the Mediterranean Sea with the Atlantic Ocean. Nestled in the mountains 12 miles from the Mediterranean, Chateau Coulon benefits from the Mediterranean winds that blow for more than 200 days per year, and a warm and dry microclimate. The estate has never used pesticides, herbicides or any chemical products in the vineyards. The result is a pure, fruity wine with aromas of black olive tapenade and sandalwood, and flavors of red cherries, black fruits and spices. Serve with duck, grilled lamb chops, steaks, or any Mediterranean food.
