Château Coutet, one of the oldest estates in Sauternes, prides itself on its exalted past. Its buildings date from the end of the thirteenth century.

In 1788, it was bought by Mr. Gabriel Barthélémy Romain de Filhot, President of the Bordeaux Parliament, and was owned by his family for more than a century. His grandson, the Marquis Romain Bertrand de Lur Saluces, became the world's greatest producer of sweet white wine. Classified a first growth in 1855, its successive owners have always maintained a very high level of quality. Château Coutet's wine is painstakingly vinified in the purest tradition and combines both style and elegance with delicacy. It epitomizes the sumptuousness of a great Sauternes.
