Hand harvested grapes on Friday August 13th at the point of optimal ripe maturity and fresh acidity. Fermented using T73 Rioja isolate yeast chosen to optimize minerality. Aged eight months in a 30-gallon medium toast French oak barrel. No fining or filtration.

A fresh and bright version of a tempranillo not expected from the hot and arid central Texas conditions. Please enjoy this single barrel production 'joen' style wine. Freely with passion,
