The fruit for this wine was picked in perfect conditions during the cool early mornings of late September and early October and shows a superb deep velvety red in colour, almost black and is marked by it's beautiful Cabernet character. On the nose it displays fresh & lush rich notes of black plums, cassis, raspberry and figs with fine leather, hints of ginger, spice and soft vanillary new oak. On the palate, it is full-bodied with firm but carefully weighted tannins, which become more defined as the wine lingers in the wine lingers in the mouth with dense savoury and earthy characters leading towards a rounded, supple, blackberry and plum finish that displays good restraint and poise.
