62% Cabernet Sauvignon - 11% Merlot - 12% Cabernet Franc - 7% Carménère - 7% Syrah - 1% Petit Verdot

ANKA (meaning "full moon's belly" in the native mapuche language) is a complex red blend that is immediately enjoyable. This wine was produced from 100% estate-grown grapes, farmed with environmentally friendly practices. Fewer than 2,500 cases were made.

ANKA displays a deep red color with an attractive nose that recalls plums and strawberry ananas mingled with roasted pepper notes and toasty hints of integrated oak. In the mouth, it displays a vibrant composition of fresh fruit and sweet spices. In order to protect the purity of the fruit, this wine was subject to minimal handling prior to bottling.
