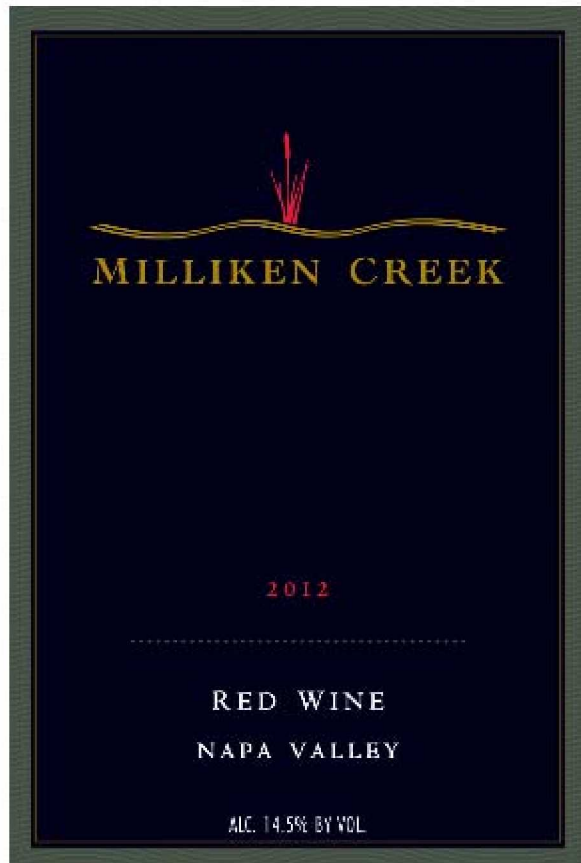

The 11.9 mile long Milliken Creek begins at an altitude of 1,850 feet in Foss Valley and meanders down from just below Atlas Peak, through the Silverado Country Club property to the town of Napa where it joins the Napa River at 10 feet above sea level. The Milliken Creek divides our vineyards into specific soil types by its drainage and flood patterns and provides frost protection for our Right-Bank Bordeaux style grapes. We planted our vineyards in 1978 and farm sustainably to bring forward the best possible fruit for our Milliken Creek wines.
