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CHÂTEAU TANUNDA 50 YEAR OLD VINES BAROSSA CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Château Tanunda, Icon of the Barossa, was established in 1890 and is the site of some of the Valley's earliest vines as well as its first winery. The Château is privately owned by the Geber family who continue a tradition of fine winemaking spanning three centuries.

From a single vineyard in the the Penrice sub-region of the Barossa, these low-yielding "Barossa Old Vines" were planted more than fifty years ago. Their root structure and trunk thickness encourages diversity of flavour and character. Their worthiness has been proven over many vintages, consistently producing the highest quality fruit for Barossa wines of distinction and longevity. The grapes are destemmed, but not crushed, and spend seven days on their skins in open fermenters with twice daily hand-plunging and pumping over of the cap to more gently extract colour, flavours and tannins. This is followed by careful basket pressing. Maturation is in French oak barrels for 24 months. In keeping with our non-interventionist winemaking style we have neither fined nor filtered this wine and as a result a harmless deposit may form and decanting is recommended. Enjoy now or cellar carefully for up to ten years from vintage.
