The **.36 White** has more in common with moonshine than the bourbon it becomes after maturation. More than anything, it gives you an appreciation for how much the oak barrel transforms the spirit. Instead of being made for sipping like our standard .36, the .36 White is made for mixing. It is powerful but also slightly sweet, grainy, and fruity, allowing the Texas corn to play a prominent role. Try it side by side with the aged Ranger Creek .36 for an educational experience, mix it with fruit in a mason jar like moonshine, or use it as a flavorful alternative to vodka in a Bloody Mary or Martini.
