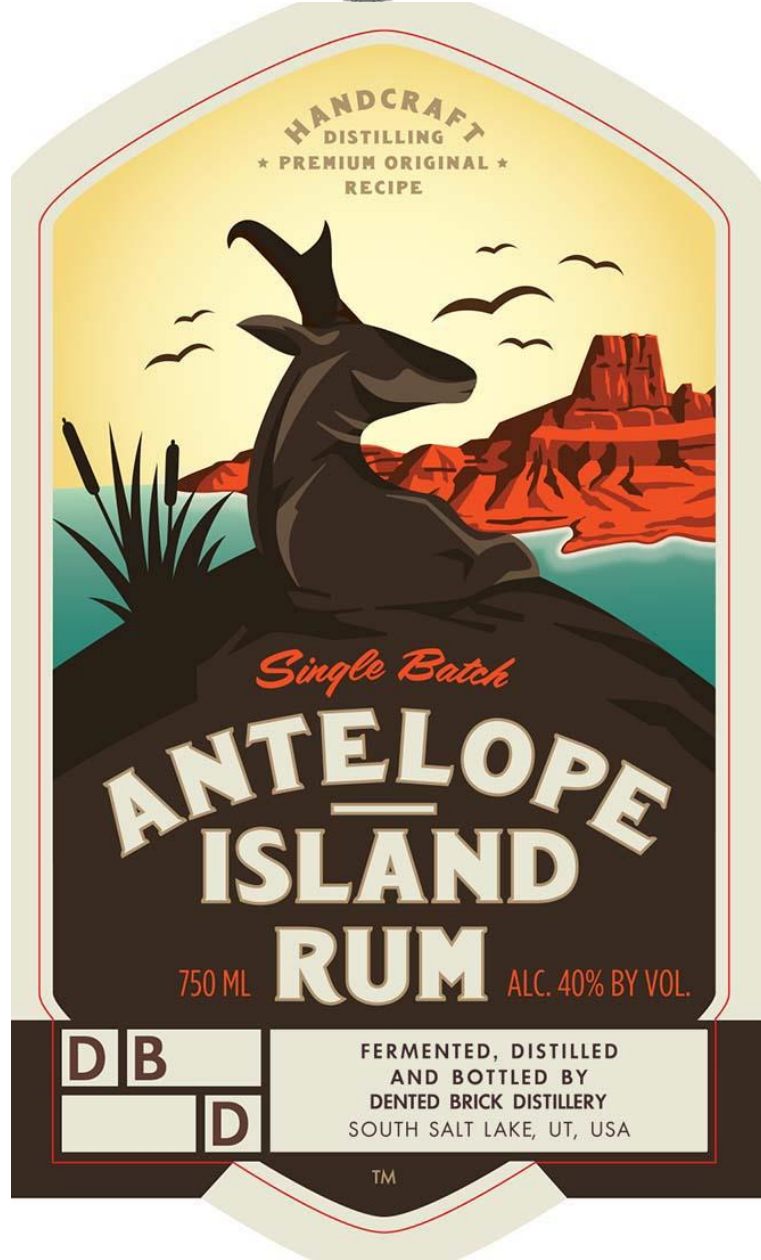

ANTELOPE ISLAND IS IN THE SOUTHERN PART OF THE GREAT SALT LAKE. ARTIFACTS DISCOVERED THERE SHOW THAT THE ISLAND WAS OCCUPIED BY PREHISTORIC PEOPLE MORE THAN 6,000 YEARS AGO. EXPLORED BY KIT CARSON AND JOHN C. FREMONT IN 1845, THEY NAMED IT ANTELOPE ISLAND AFTER THE HERDS OF GRAZING PRONGHORN. PART OF THE ISLAND HAS SINCE BECOME A 28,240 ACRE WILDLIFE REFUGE FOR BISON, ANTELOPE AND OVER 250 SPECIES OF BIRDS.
