The Cabernet Sauvignon from 1221 is quite the decadent, densely layered and full-bodied wine. The grapes are sourced from some of the highest quality vineyards that call Sonoma County home. The grapes were hand-picked, fermented and aged in separate distinct lots, thus creating intricacies of flavors and textures prior to final blending. The resultant wine possesses complex oak tannins that are very big, yet very well integrated. Overall, a very 'Cabernet-style' Cabernet Sauvignon. Quite delicious, silky and lush. Drinkable now, but will age very nicely for another 5-10 years.

Food Pairings: filet mignon with a black peppercorn sauce, lamb chops with rosemary and dark chocolate.
