Construit en 1120, ce château est le plus ancien du Médoc. Dès 1400, c'est la demeure de la famille de Foix, inféodée au roi d'Angleterre. En 1486, Carnet en devient le propriétaire. La famille de Michel de Montaigne en prend possession vers 1500. En 1855, le vin de La Tour Carnet accède au Classement des Grands Crus Classés. Composés de 71% MERLOT, 24% CABERNET SAUVIGNON, 3% CABERNET FRANC et 2% PETIT VERDOT, les vins de La Tour Carnet sont élevés 16 mois en barriques de chêne français et sont présents sur les plus grandes tables du monde. La vendange 2007 a débuté le 27 septembre.

Built in 1120, our château is the oldest of the Médoc Region. Owned in 1400 by the house of Foix, loyal to the King of England. In 1486, Carnet became the new owner. The family of Michel de Montaigne owned the domaine in the 1500s. This Haut-Médoc, classified in 1855 Grand Cru Classé, is made from hand selected 71% MERLOT, 24% CABERNET SAUVIGNON, 3% CABERNET FRANC and 2% PETIT VERDOT grapes. Aged 16 months in French oak barrels and served at the world's best table. The 2007 harvest began September 27th.

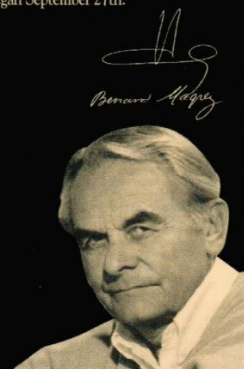
