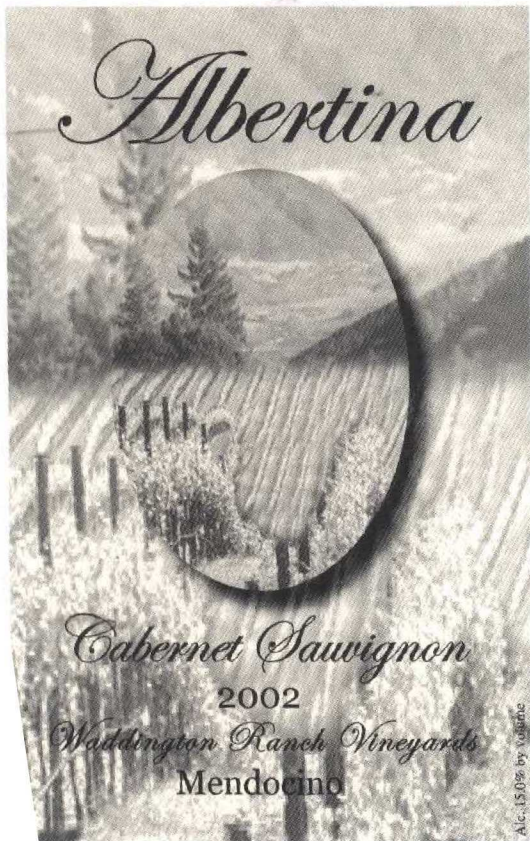

Albertina is a boutique winery specializing in hand-crafted ultra-premium mountain grown Cabernet Sauvignon wines. Mountain vineyards grow more intensely flavored grapes. The unique micro climate of the high elevations conspire with the red loam soils to produce small berries with concentrated flavors and superb color.

This wine is 100% Cabernet Sauvignon from the Waddington Ranch Vineyards. The grapes were patiently tended on the vine until optimum flavor & ripeness was reached. The sun ripened clusters were then hand picked in small bins. The wine was fermented to dryness before pressing, and aged in small French, American and Hungarian oak barrels for 20 months. The result: An engaging fruit-forward wine with soft tannins and jammy overtones that is especially enjoyed with beef, lamb and pasta dishes.
