Sourced from two noteworthy Sierra Foothills vineyards, Cooper Vineyards in Amador (50%) and Goedeck Vineyards in El Dorado County (50%), our 2013 Petite Sirah is deep, rich, and dark. Flavors of ripe blackberries, wild blueberries, and huckleberries are followed by black pepper, corns, dark chocolate and slight notes of tobacco and cedar. All framed together with firm tannins, the flavors dance in your mouth long after the wine is gone. Try with sausage polenta, stuffed roast pork loin, or bacon-wrapped filet mignon.
