During prohibition in Norway, the Norwegian politicians decided that they still had to have their Bache so they allowed sales of 3 Kors at pharmacies. The cross was a symbol for a pharmacy. So instead of being a three star Cognac, it is a three cross (3 Kors) Cognac. Still.

3Kors has a lively, youthful aroma with a fruity nose and a slight edge of young Grande Champagne Cognac that is full of character. In addition, the round, mellow palate has a relatively soft, fruity finish.
