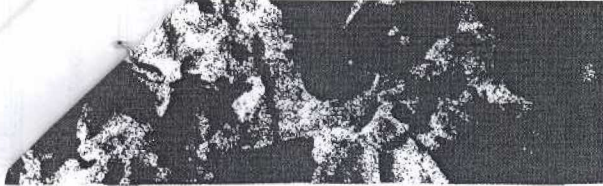

AROMA

Blueberry skin, violets, pine needle

FLAVOR

Blue fruits, spice box, cedar

FOOD PAIRINGS

Braised short ribs, Asian-marinated flank steak

VINIFICATION

A blend of old-vine Carignan (87%) and Petite Sirah (13%). The fruit was hand harvested and sorted on November 1. It was co-fermented using wild yeast and aged in older barrels for 10-months. Bottling was done without fining or filtration.

SITE

A selection of benchland vineyards in Mendocino's cool Redwood Valley compose this wine. The goal is to clearly express the unique varietal character of this old-vine fruit which was for years blended into obscurity. The combination of vine age, an extended growing season, and tougher, rocky soil conspire to produce complex, intense wines.
