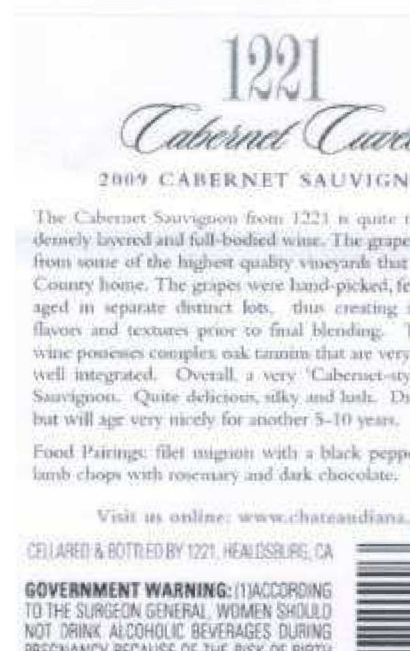

The wine possesses complex oak tannins that are very well integrated. Overall, a very 'Cabernet-style' Sauvignon. Quite delicious, silky, and lush. But will age very nicely for another 5-10 years.
