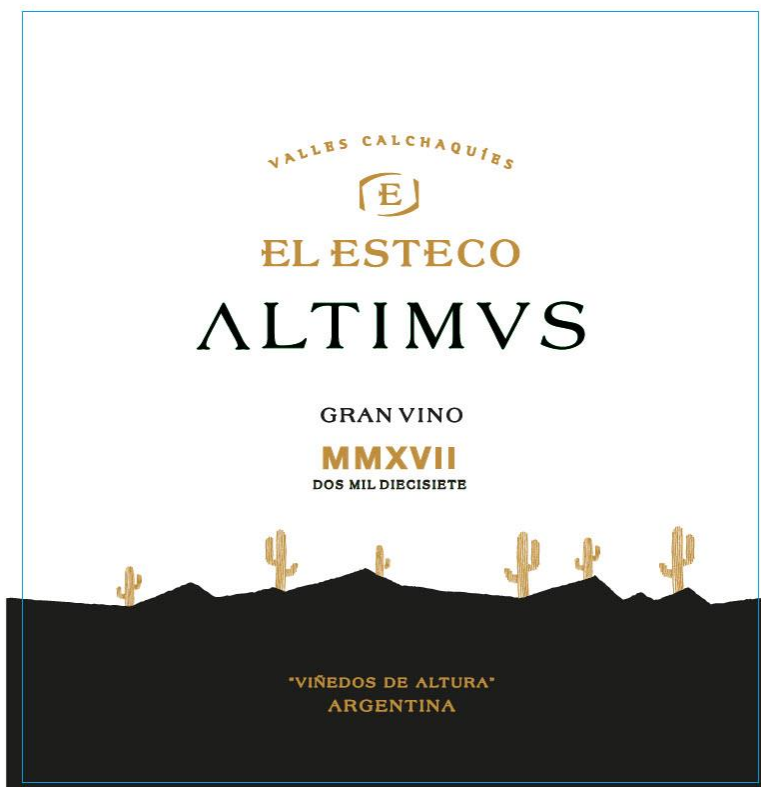

Cafayate Valley, standing at above 1,700 masl /5,600 fasl, is one of the highest altitude winemaking regions in the world. A magical place in the far north of Argentina, and the birthplace of Altimus. This unique blend of **Cabernet Sauvignon (49%)**, **Malbec (32%)**, **Cabernet Franc (16%)** and **Merlot (3%)** is sourced from especially selected vines. Each variety is separately aged in new French oak barrels for 12 months. Only then is the blend made and the wine left to age for an additional 6 months. This wine boasts a vibrant, deep red colour with ruby hues. The typicity of Cabernet Sauvignon stands out on the nose, evoking spicy aromas of mint, black pepper and cassia. The intensity of Malbec emerges on the palate with fruity and fresh notes which, combined with spices and pepper, make for a fresh and round attack. This full array of features translate into an elegant wine with great concentration and maturity, and a persistently lingering finish. Ageing potential: 20 years. Bottled without filtering or stabilising in order to preserve its natural attributes. Uncork 30 minutes before serving and let it aerate in a decanter. Recommended serving temperature: 17°C to 18°C (63 - 64.5 °F)
