STORY: In the alluvial soils of the Aconcagua Valley you'll find granite and quartz under layers of sand and red clay. Here with warm summer days and the cool Pacific Ocean breezes, Pinot Noir can ripen slowly. Then the grapes are hand harvested, gently crushed, and chilled prior to fermentation to extract color and flavor.

TASTE: Earthy with notes of blueberries and cherries on the nose. The wine is fermented in stainless steel and then aged for 6 months in neutral French oak. The result is quite the elegant Pinot Noir ready to be sipped alongside seared duck breast with a pomegranate-citrus glaze or garlic and herb marinated pork tenderloin.
