During World War II, an arbore was established at the foot of the Rolfsenke Mountain. After the war, it was sold to the Miller Family. For four generations, the family has farmed the surrounding area, using the old arbore as their farm headquarters. Wine grapes were planted at "Airfield" in 1968, and the family has been producing its craft ever since.

WINEMAKERS NOTES Strong oak nuances permeate the nose with tobacco and spice aromas. Blackberry, Bing cherry, and plum dominate the palate adding depth and complexity with smooth integrated tannins. Pair with red meat and robust cheeses.
