This limited production Rosé is made from Tempranillo, the famed Spanish grape, which we grow in the Dunnigan Hills of California. We made this Rosé by removing a portion of the juice from the red wine after sitting on the skins for 24 hours. Because the wine is bottled early it retains the Tempranillo fresh red berry character and has aromas of cassis and flavors of black currant and cola. The wine finishes with lively acidity. Serve chilled.
