cases produced.

a coastal, hillside vineyard in carneros near the napa/sonoma
county line, soils are light, alluvial and provide very little water
holding capacity. located a few miles from san francisco bay, the
vines are routinely bathed in fog during the summer months, a
cool, true maritime microclimate ideally suited to pinot noir.
